FULL CIRCLE

I remember it well. The newly formed-board of the Friends had spent 1987 setting up non-profit administrative stuff and finally went public in the autumn. By then, we had collected a few hundred dollars. I received a call from Bob Powers, asking if he could attend a board meeting. Bob was (still is) lead archaeologist for our region of the National Park Service (NPS). Back in the 1970s, Congress had decreed that government agencies shall inventory all their holdings. NPS charged Bob with inventorying the Southwest Region's archaeological resources!! Bob diligently set to work, one park at a time. By 1988 he was ready to start working on Bandelier's 32,000 acres. He came to the Friends' board with an interesting opportunity.

Bob had met Washington State University archaeologist Tim Kohler, who had just finished work on the massive Dolores Project in southern Colorado. His findings there made Tim curious as to what led Pueblo people to aggregate from small, few-family farmsteads through larger communities to the large towns we know so well at Chaco Canyon, Mesa Verde, and Bandelier. It was apparent to both scientists that Bandelier was a perfect research area for studying the question. Tim estimated that he would need funding in excess of \$100,000. Bob asked our fledging board for \$5,000. It was the right type of request for our group, but we didn't have the money. (Responsible non-profits don't borrow.) We finally pledged whatever funds we acquired by the time Tim needed them.

We actually did meet the goal and went on to grant Tim money for further excavations, special studies, graduate student research projects, and publications. In applying for funding from other sources, Tim would cite our grants as evidence of local support for his work. One year he received the entire archaeology allocation from the National Science Foundation. During Bob's simultaneous NPS-funded survey of Bandelier, he occasionally came back to us for help. We would grant \$2,000, which paid for a couple days of survey. Impressed that the private sector contributed, NPS funded for two more whole weeks.

Fast-forwarding to the autumn of 2003, I again received a call from Bob. He needed funds to help the School of American Research (SAR) of Santa Fe produce a non-technical book interpreting archaeological findings at Bandelier. The Friends board granted \$5,000. For me, the only remaining member of the original board, there was a satisfying feeling of coming full circle. The book incorporates many of the bits and pieces of research we helped to fund over the years into a comprehensive look at prehistoric life at Bandelier. Because that life was not unique to Bandelier, the book helps depict developments throughout the pueblo Southwest.

We signed a memorandum of Agreement with SAR and NPS. Because most of the contributing authors wrote their chapters on company time, they can't collect royalties for their work. The SAR wants to cycle profits from the book back to Bandelier. They decided that the most efficient and cost-effective way is to funnel royalties through the Friends. Although SAR will not restrict our use of the funds to archaeology, the board always welcomes archaeological requests.

WHITHER THE FRIENDS?

Bandelier staff has been busy gearing up to implement its 5-year Strategic Plan. Renovating the Visitor Center looms large in the Plan, which calls for adding a new auditorium, moving the bookstore into the present auditorium, installing completely new exhibits, and rendering the building more energy-efficient. Chief of Interpretation Lynne Dominy wants to incorporate some objects from Bandelier's permanent collection into the new exhibits. "Why have them if nobody sees them?" she asks. Superintendent Darlene Koontz and Lynne expect to direct future Friends' grants toward meeting the Strategic Plan's objectives. We look forward to seeing what they come up with; we hope that you will too.

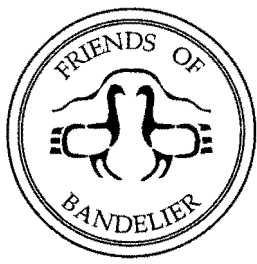

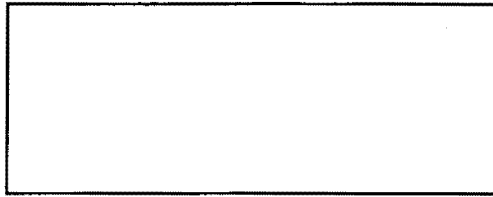
