ANNUAL REPORT for 2007

We are delighted to announce that the National Park Service has awarded Bandelier matching funds for their two Centennial Challenge Grant proposals. The competition turned out to be a brutal and rather sad one. The Bush Administration asked Congress for \$100 million to be matched dollar for dollar by the private sector. The National Park Service (NPS) rather quickly gathered nonfederal matching guarantees in excess of \$200 million, leaving NPS to select no more than \$100 million-worth of proposals. Then, Congress only allocated \$25 million to the program. This left NPS with the painful chore of eliminating three-quarters of the proposals it initially had accepted.

Bandelier was one of very few parks to get two awards and the only park in New Mexico to get any Centennial Grant at all. One grant, *Modeling Sustainability at Bandelier*, will develop a five-year prioritized plan for energy efficiency regarding a 1930s facilities in a deep canyon. Then the rangers set out to implement the plan.

The other grant, *Identifying Non-Traditional Park Visitor Needs at Bandelier*, funds focus groups to determine ways to make parks more relevant for minority citizens, in Bandelier's case, Hispanics and Native Americans. We expect these two projects to occupy the rangers for the remainder of the year. We have already transferred the Friends' matching funds to the park: \$27,500 for sustainability and \$12,500 for focus groups.

Chief of Interpretation Lynne Dominy and I went to the Centennial Inaugural Ceremony in Washington DC. Several congressmen from both parties spoke; all were very proud of getting the funding through both houses of Congress. Each speaker commented that the American public wants Congress to do something bipartisan and positive; national parks fit both those categories.

Bandelier still has the cliff-hanger request before Congress for \$3.75 million to remodel the Visitor Center and update the interpretive exhibits. In the President's budget, the request is #17 of the 17 line-items in the NPS construction request for fiscal year 2009. Last year, the park purchased crafts for new exhibits, some of which the Friends funded. Even without a remodeled Visitor Center (very badly needed), the craft items are a valuable edition to Bandelier's collections, documenting Pueblo crafts at this point in time. As part of the refurbishing, the rangers have already installed new exhibit panels in front of and on the back portal of the Visitor Center.

In 1994, the Friends provided matching funds for a pilot study called piñon-juniper restoration, which was actually in its second year at the time. Subsequently, Bandelier received funding to do a study on a watershed scale. In 2007 the rangers issued an Environmental Impact Statement to apply the restoration techniques on all the park's piñon-juniper woodland. At last, in 2008, work has begun! This last winter, Chief of Resource Management, John Mack, treated accessible areas along the entrance road and State Road 4. His crews now have moved into the backcountry. I call the treatment "slash and trash," and would normally be horrified at the mess, except that it works so well. Actually, the roadside treatment does not look too bad. (Los Alamos National Laboratory is now using the technique as well.) Most visitors probably will not even notice. We will check on vegetation recovery and let you know how it progresses; good success really will depend on how much rain we receive.

In other news of the Friends' 2007 assistance to Bandelier, the Pablita Velarde exhibit in Santa Fe went so well that the Museum of Indian Arts and Culture kept the paintings hanging for an extra month. Bread-baking sessions in the Frijoles Canyon horno (oven) were great fun and holiday Pueblo dances were well attended. These programs are important to Bandelier managers as part of the on-going cultural demonstrations. They encourage surrounding Pueblos to maintain their affinities with Bandelier.

We are also funding Los Alamos High School webwhiz Colin MacArthur for 2007-2008 in an effort to make the Park Service's klutzy (technical term) web site more user-friendly and descriptive of Bandelier's many diverse activities. As usual, Bandelier always gets more than our money's worth from these young people.

This annual report is rather late, but we did not really have much to say until we knew the outcome of the Centennial Grants. We hope you find Bandelier's adventures adventuresome enough to say tuned!

STATE OF THE PARK

MAY 2008

We have exciting news from Washington D.C. about the Centennial Challenge money...both Bandelier projects were funded by Congress with the matching money given by the Friends of Bandelier. Dorothy and Lynne traveled to D.C. to accept the funding from the Secretary of Interior, Dirk Kempthorne, and the Director of the National Park Service, Mary Bomar. The NPS hosted a big announcement ceremony on the steps of the Capitol building and a rooftop reception at the Interior Building.

Both Centennial projects will start in May. Bandelier will begin its efforts to become more environmentally sustainable by hosting a "Climate Friendly Parks" workshop May 13-14 with park partners and community members. This workshop will educate park staff about the park's carbon footprint and will result in a 5-year sustainability plan. It will also enable the park to prioritize the sustainability actions that will make "the biggest difference" and to spend the centennial/ Friends money to implement some of those priorities.

The second project will create a partnership with the Social Science Laboratory at Northern Arizona University to develop the process for assuring that Bandelier is relevant to New Mexicans who do not currently visit the park. Using focus groups and interviews, NAU professors and students will determine what Bandelier should be doing to better serve Pueblo and Hispanic communities in particular. They will then compile recommendations for park management on ways to better serve these audiences. Researchers will also gather some feedback about New Mexico State Parks – who recently contributed an additional \$10,000 toward this project.

The Centennial Initiative has also given the park a \$50,000 base increase to fund seasonal positions. This funding will enable a teacher from Aldine School district to return this summer to design an interactive webranger program for Bandelier (visit www.nps.gov/webrangers to see a sample). It will enable Len and Cathy Scheel to rebuild the park's volunteer program and to recruit new volunteers. The funding is

also being used to "track and adversely condition" a nuisance bear that won't leave Frijoles Canyon. A seasonal employee has been hired to respond to all reports of bears in Frijoles Canyon and to assist the law enforcement staff with harassing bears that enter the "no bear zone" recently established by park management around the Main Loop Trail. These efforts are intended to save the nuisance bear's life by conditioning it to fear people before it has negative interactions with them. This employee has also been assisting with the monitoring of problem cattle that are in the park along the Rio Grande on the Falls Trail. The Superintendent is currently working to have these cattle removed.

In addition to these Centennial projects, the resource management staff will continue to implement the ecological restoration project. This work has been completed at Tsankawi and along the park entrance road, and will now move into the backcountry. The Vanishing Treasures crews will continue their conservation efforts in Frijoles Canyon with work in Big Kiva and the cavates. Lauren Meyer, the new VT

program manager, will lead all of these efforts. The archeology program also welcomes a new archeologist, Jamie Civitello. Rory Gauthier and his staff will be completing assessments for all of the areas that have been identified as priorities for prescribed burning and for ecological restoration.

Bandelier is also proud to welcome a new Facility Manager, Liza Ermeling from Glen Canyon NRA. Liza and her staff will be busy completing the sewage lift station project and other park infrastructure projects that have received funding. They are also working with many volunteer trail crews to repair park trails, especially those in Frijoles Canyon that keep getting damaged by flash floods.

Bandelier is thrilled with the success of its first big prescribed burn since Cerro Grande. The Unit 9 Burn treated 1500 acres near the cross-country ski trails. Fire management staff will continue with mechanical thinning this year and will do their next prescribed burn in Frijoles Canyon this fall. The plan is to burn upstream of the visitor center to reduce fuels in this high-use area (weather and conditions permitting).


Planning is wrapping-up for the renovation of the historic visitor center. Funding for this project is currently in the President's 2009 budget and the renovations will begin in August/September 2009 if the funding stays in the appropriations. The first twelve new exhibits have been fabricated and will be installed in May. The rest will be completed in 2009 in conjunction with the building renovations. The new park movie is still being filmed and edited with aerial footage scheduled for this summer.

A new Junior Ranger program will be available midsummer with new age-specific activities and four levels of free patches available for kids (funded by the National Park Foundation and the centennial initiative). Adults will still be able to participate in the Deputy Ranger program and earn a free patch. You can look at these new materials on the park website at www.nps.gov/band. Len Scheel and Chris Judson are also creating a Bandelier Steward program for youth groups, including Boy and Girl Scouts, which will enable them to earn a special patch. They will also be creating recommendations for how Boy and Girl Scouts at all levels can work to earn their scout patches at different locations throughout the park.

Friends-funded Los Alamos High School intern, Colin MacArthur, will complete his internship at Bandelier in May. He has been working hard with park webmaster, Sally King, to plan the park website. Colin has been interviewing the park staff and canvassing the public about what is most important to them. He will provide a report to the Friends of Bandelier in May showing his accomplishments.

Nightwalks will be on Wednesday nights this summer and the park always needs volunteers to help with torches. Contact Park Ranger Chris Judson (672-3861, ext. 517) if you are able to help. Cultural demonstrations will continue to be offered on weekends and holidays. Don't miss the special dance demonstrations on the Sundays of holiday weekends. Be sure to check the park website for the schedule of monthly events and special activities.
